ASHBURN	Hampton represents the black and Hispanic population of Ashburn well, none of the schools in Ashburn represent the white population of Ashburn
AUBURN GRESHAM	All of the schools have a high racial correlation to Auburn Gresham
AUSTIN	Sayre is the most diverse racially and economically, but doesn't have a high racial correlation to Austin
AVALON PARK	Caldwell has the lowest percentage of disadvantaged students
AVONDALE	None of the schools accurately represent the racial makeup of Avondale
BELMONT CRAGIN	Steinmetz is the most racially and (relatively) economically diverse
BEVERLY	Sutherland has closest correlation with racial makeup of Beverly, it is also the most diverse and has lowest percentage of disadvantaged students. Kellogg has most economic diversity
BRIDGEPORT	None of the schools correlate with the racial makeup of Bridgeport. Healy has the closest Asian correlation and the lowest percentage of disadvantaged students
BRIGHTON PARK	Kelly is the most racially diverse and has the least (relative) percentage of disadvantaged students
BURNSIDE	Washington, H has a high correlation to the racial makeup of Burnside
CALUMET HEIGHTS	Earhart has pretty significantly lower percentage of disadvantaged students. It might be worth exploring why that is
CHATHAM	McDade is the most racially and economically diverse, and still correlates pretty highly with the racial makeup of Chatham
CHICAGO LAWN	Marquette and Morrill are both more relatively racially diverse, but Morrill is the most economically diverse
CLEARING	Dore is the most racially and economically diverse
DOUGLAS	None of the schools accurately represent Douglas, but Drake is the most (relatively) racially and economically diverse
DUNNING	All the schools moderately reflect Dunning racially, and all are relatively economically diverse. Carty most accurately represents Dunning racially, and has the lowest percentage of economically disadvantaged students
EAST GARFIELD PARK	Marshall is the least (relatively) racially diverse, and has the lowest percentage of disadvantaged students
EAST SIDE	Washington, G has the highest percentage of white students and it is the most economically diverse
EDGEWATER	Swift is the most racially diverse, but none of the schools reflect the racial makeup of Edgewater.
EDISON PARK	Ebinger correlates with the racial makeup of Edison Park fairly okay, and it has a low percentage of disadvantaged students
ENGLEWOOD	Mays has the lowest percentage of disadvantaged students
FOREST GLEN	Both schools relatively economically diverse, Edgebrook has lower percentage of disadvantaged students and more accurately reflects the racial makeup of the community area
FULLER PARK	Hendricks correlates highly with the racial makeup of Fuller Park
GAGE PARK	Solorio is closer to the racial makeup of Gage Park
GARFIELD RIDGE	Byrne is the closest to the racial makeup of Garfield Ridge and it has the lowest percentage of disadvantaged students. Kinzie has the second highest correlation to the racial makeup of the community area and also has the second most economic diversity

GRAND BOULEVARD	Woodson has highest racial correlation to the community and higher percentage of disadvantaged students
GREATER GRAND CROSSING	All of the schools reflect the racial makeup of the community, all of them have high percentage of disadvantaged students
HEGEWISCH	Clay is more racially and economically diverse
HERMOSA	All schools reflect racial makeup of Hermosa, and all have high percentage of disadvantaged students
HUMBOLDT PARK	Casals most accurately represents racial makeup of community
